

## PE&SSPF- Report for Governors- 28.9.16

### ➤ **National Curriculum & Extra Curriculum 2016/17-**

Following the meeting with DCCT on 3.5.16 (notes have been circulated previously) the school is in receipt of a quality assured programme as the deliverers hold the Level 3 Qualification. As a partner school we are committed to 22 free hours which will allow us to access "Plus Sport Move and Learn" - this involves 50% classroom and 50 % practical work and involves the core sports of Handball, Softball, Football. This is being delivered on Friday afternoons and is providing cross curricular activities including Science, PHSE and PE. DCCT will be providing the National Curriculum on Tuesday afternoons- The timetable is attached. As in previous years the children evaluate their work and set targets for the next lesson. The Outdoor Activity element of the National Curriculum will be met during the visit to Whitehall in October by Year 6. After School Club is delivered by DCCT every Tuesday afternoon 3.30-4.30 and attended by all children. A new initiative of Tai Chi is being delivered on Thursday 3.30 4.30 attended by all children and several parents. This is proving very popular. **Inclusion-** the work the school and DCCT has done with Martin Mansell- ensures that a fully Inclusive programme is in place. Martin has expressed his support for the work that DCCT are doing.

### ➤ **Links with Clubs and Cluster Competitions/festivals-**

It has been highlighted by QEGS staff and leaders the quality of skill level the children demonstrate when participating against much larger schools. The 2015/16 results /celebration Sainsbury display board reflects their achievements. They also have the Social, Moral, Spiritual and Culture (SMSS) ideals embedded in all that they do. DCCT can also provide a programme which will support the Intra- school competition elements which are difficult to fulfil when you are so small. The QEGS Cluster Primary Competition Calendar has been received and with Biggin Primary School we will participate as BIGGHARTS to ensure access. All results are recorded in the Parish Magazine and on the School website. The support of Parents with transport is very much appreciated.
