

Report to Hartington C of E Primary School Governors- PE&SSP funding- January 19th 2017

- **National Curriculum & Extra Curriculum 2017-** In January, February and March the focus is on Gymnastics which is delivered by Megan from DCCT, some of the weeks within After School Club, Gymnastics will also be available. On January 16th Years 1&2 participated in a Gymnastic festival at QEGS. The Healthy Schools Community Award- The audit of the school provision has been completed and an action plan produced. Targets are linked to the Early Years Outdoor Provision which includes the development of a peer buddying system, e.safety for children, parents, governors and the development of positive behaviour (which the school is to link to the Anti- Bullying Award and British Values) Tai- Chi sessions have started for another 6 week block.
- **Links with Clubs and Cluster Competitions/Festivals-** The Sainsbury Display and results board has been updated to reflect the results of participation between September and December. Full reports are available in the Parish Magazine- News and Views- as well as the children receiving certificates and acknowledgments as part of the Celebration Assemblies.
- **Rural Derbyshire School Sports Programme RDSSP-**The payments received for last year 2015/16 was £6208. For 2016/17 we have received £6000 of which £2733 has been spent on DCCT, Tai Chi and promotional/Website consultancy. A date is to be confirmed when I will represent the school at a “Covey” Meeting with Janice Price; the other small schools we will work with are, Biggin, Fenny Bentley and Winster. A case study has been compiled, which outlines the impact that PE&SSPF has had on the lifelong involvement of Children who attended this school over the last 10 years. This impact has been both within School and in the School Activity Club-HYPAC. This is available for Governors with this report; it has also been sent to Janice Price at RDSSP as an example of good practice
- **RDSSP Sainsbury Sports Mark-** I attended Wirksworth Community Centre on January 11th to collect the Silver Award for Hartington C of E Primary School. The application dates and criteria for this coming year were provided and I have shared with the Head teacher
- **Impact of PE&SSPF 2015/16 and the 2016-19 Action Plan-** The impact document for 2015/16 which is required to be available on the website has been completed. A copy is available here for Governors. The Action Plan has now been agreed and will also be available on the website
