

## PE & School Sport Premium Funding- Report to Governors- 21.9.17

### **Income & Expenditure- October 2016- August 2017- Summary-**

The Income total was £7695.00 and the Expenditure total £6798.00. The details of these accounts are available for Governors to see and the activities will form the basis of the 2016/17 PE&SSPF Impact document which will be available for governors at the next meeting and will be then placed on the school website. QEGS requested quotes from students and staff for their Impact report- these are quoted here.

Governor responsible for PE&SSPF – “The competitive and festival opportunities which QEGS provide to the cluster are essential and of a high quality. Without them, small rural schools, such as ourselves would not be able to provide this critical element to our pupils.”

Y4 pupil said: “It's fun and exciting when we go to QEGS to do sports. I also feel nervous because I don't know what is going to happen and I worry I might let my friends down!”

Y6 pupil said: “I enjoy the sports events because the referees make it fun and fair when we play all the different sports against other primary schools. Also it is exciting playing with children our age, which we don't often get chance to do because we are such a small school.”

### **Planning meeting for 2017/18 with DCCT-**

This was held on 3.5.17 with Headteacher –Mrs Blackwell; Participation Manager Derby County Community Trust (DCCT)- Rich Mansfield and Vice Chair of Governors (responsibility for PE&SSPF)- Liz Broomhead MBE. The full minutes of the meeting are available in the PE folder. To summarize-

- The objectives for 2016/17 were realised- these were- Quality Teaching; Childrens Performance, self-analysis and aspirations to improve; Focus on Gymnastics and Dance
- Focus for 2017/18- Sustainable development through mentor support of staff; develop more links with local clubs- (registration with FA Premier League- “Primary Stars”)
- Partners School Programme- we have entered into a contract which will provide a wider range of opportunities including PSHE Celebration Assembly and Virtual Competitions
- We will expand the after school club in terms 2,3 and 4 to include Thursday as well as Tuesday
- **Derbyshire Sport- A Physical Activity and Sport Framework for Young People 2017-2021- Young Active Healthy-**We has identified 2 of the 5 Delivery Themes which the school will focus on-**Active Schools and Early Years Providers** -this will be aligned with the SIP- Early Years Programme - **Active Families and Communities-** this will be linked with HYPAC. The school has agreed a contract of delivery with DCCT which will be funded from the increased budget available for 2017/18 of £16000 plus and extra £150 per pupil. We hope to use some of this funding could be offset against the additional dance.

**The programme for the curriculum and staff mentoring- 2017/18 has been agreed** – to enable staff to access the mentor support it will be necessary to use the funding to release staff.

### **QEGS Sports Development Offer-**

For this year, we will again join with Biggin Primary School, to form BIGGHARTS. This partnership allows use to pay 50% each towards the fee as well as ensuring that we can enter at least 1 and often 2 squads into the competitions and festivals. Our results and performances continue to be of the highest standard and are acknowledged in the celebration assemblies, School Games Silver Mark Notice Board and the parish magazine- News and Views.
