

World Book Day Activities

On Wednesday 5th March, we celebrated World Book Day. We shared an Assembly with those at home on Google Classroom- 'Live' at 10am- a chance to show off your World Book Day costumes!

Our focus Author this year was: Julia Donaldson, so we learnt more about her and what else she enjoys. We then shared some of our favourite Julia Donaldson books with someone else; we discussed why we like it, our favourite parts and favourite characters.

We read, as a class, 'The Scarecrow's Wedding' and listed together what they collected for their wedding?

EYFS & YR1- Found the pictures around the room, matched the pictures together- Which animal found each item? They then created their own 'split-pin' scarecrow.

YR2-6 Designed a wedding invitation for their wedding, after discussing what an invitation needed to have on it.

We read 'Zog', as a class and then listed together the things that Zog needed to learn each year in Madam Dragon's School and how Zog faced challenges with each:

- in Year 1 he learned to fly and crashed into a tree
- in Year 2 he learned to roar and made his throat hoarse
- in Year 3 he learned to blow fire and his wing tip caught alight
- in Year 4 he learnt how to capture a princess
- in Year 5 he learned to fight a knight

EYFS/Yr1 became flying doctors- role play with the doctor's bag and costume.

In the afternoon we read 'Rumble in the Jungle' Poem. We then were given our own animal each and a mask and we had to practice our animal's poem. We learnt it from memory and performed it with sounds and animal movements.

At the end of the day we had Story Time- 'Live' at 2.30pm- Class 2 read out their stories and showed the books they had created. We then had a go at answering the Quiz comprehension questions they had designed for us.
