FUNDRAISING

NATIVITY & PEA & PIE SUPPER 10.12.2015

Guy Debes and his father to supply mulled wine for the supper. Agreed to supply enough for 50 people. Other drinks to be provided are wine and beer leftover from the gift night. Additional beer donated by Ruby to also be sold. Tea, coffee and squash will be provided as part of the meal. All alcohol will be chargeable. Tickets are already printed, £5 per adult and £3 per child. Posters and flyers are already printed.

Raffle tickets have been printed and donated by the Wager family. Tickets to be sold for £1 per ticket and come in books of 5 tickets to be given to parents to sell and sold around the village. 1st prize – Christmas Hamper, 2nd prize – Kindle, 3rd prize - 2 badges for Uttoxeter races, 4th prize – Patrons pack for Bakewell Show 2016. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

- Tracy Blackwell would like some support funding the Clever Cloggers sessions at school. These sessions are currently £200 per session and 8 sessions are currently booked. PTFA will pay £600 towards these costs.
- PTFA will pay for pantomime trip for the children. Approximately £190 plus the cost of ice-creams
- School may need to approach the PTFA in the near future for help funding a teacher or teaching assistant. PTFA have monies put aside already for such an occasion
- Lea Green will be subsidized by the PTFA. 16 children to Lea Green and 4 children to Whitehall. This is to be discussed in more detail in a future meeting.
