

## PE&SSPF- Report for Governors- 14.7.16

- **Curriculum /National Curriculum-** This term we have extended the provision by Derby County Community Trust (DCCT) which will mean that they have delivered the quality programme for KS1 &KS2 as well as run the After School Club for 6 terms instead of 5. The Headteacher and I agreed that this cost was essential to maintain the standard and consistency of learning and understanding. The quality of the teaching is reflected in the performance and understanding all the children demonstrate when participating in the cluster competitions and Festivals. The Maypole Dancing (which fulfilled the Dance Composition and Choreography element of the National Curriculum) was delivered by the staff lead by Mrs Blackwell. The performance at the Flower festival was of the highest quality and reflected the skill development of all of the children. Following the meeting on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, alongside Mrs Blackwell, with the lead of DCCT – an exciting and challenging programme has been agreed for 2016/17.
  
- **Competition/Festivals-**We continue to be involved in the QEGS Cluster Events as BIGGHARTS producing some excellent results as well as demonstrating leadership and teamwork. Sadly the poor weather during this last term has meant many cancellations, however the staff have provided an alternative of intra-school athletic and sports events in school. The latest being an excellent “Sports Day” on Wednesday July 13<sup>th</sup> Results are printed in the parish Newsletter as well as displayed on the Sainsbury Sports Notice Board. Celebration Assemblies is where the certificates are presented to the children
  
- **Rural Derbyshire School Sports Programme RDSSP-** We have received the information of the offer for 2016/17 which we will again buy into. I will consult with the head teacher of Biggin to continue our partnership agreement. Mrs Blackwell and I will complete the PESS forms as well as apply for Sainsbury Kite Mark both of which will be completed by the deadlines. Mrs Parsons has produced a spread sheet which outlines income and expenditure against the SSP funding. This is available for Governors to see.

As a Governor I witness on a weekly basis the positive impact of the funding to our children.**
