

PE& School Sport Premium funding- Report to Governors- 7.12.17

- **Action Plan 2016/17 and Impact Document 2016/17** – These are now on the school website.
- **Sport Premium Funding Briefing for Head Teachers and Governors**-this was held on November 23rd at Anthony Gell School. It was a useful meeting giving further details on the amount of money to be received as well as the reporting processes required by law to be available on the school website. I was able to clarify what we could use the funding on as well as receive further detail as to the amount we were entitled to receive. There is a conflict in the amount of money which Janice Price's spreadsheet demonstrates we are entitled to, and that which the Patch officer has determined. Mrs Flower is still working on resolving this issue. I have received confirmation that the areas which have been outlined in the Match Funding application related to outdoor physical provision can use PE&SSPF as part of the application; also support for the Maths Specialist can also access this funding stream as part of a cross-curricular package.
- **Premier League Primary Stars** – we have received some high quality kit from this project
- **BIGGHARTS**- we continue to participate in as many competitions and festivals as we can, however it has been difficult to access as many as we have done in previous years as many have been arranged on a Monday after school which clashes with HYPAC. Our results are still very good
- **Curriculum delivery DCCT**- the quality of work has not been as good as was expected. The head has addressed the issues with The project co-ordinator and there has been some improvement. The Head invited Buxton Rugby Club to provide a session which was well received by both children and staff. Consideration is being given to using them in the future
- **Tai- Chi sessions** – These are delivered on Thursday afternoons with an after school club funded by PE&SSPF
- **Training for TA for DAPED- Derbyshire Approved PE Deliverer**- it is hoped that this will be accessed as we can use the funding to buy supply support to release staff. It is essential for sustainability
- **Visit by Peace Proscovia, Uganda National Netball Athlete based at Loughborough University**- Peace has been visiting us for the past 2 years and we are working as part of the International Award with a School in Uganda which she attended. On December 1st she came to meet with the children to share her experiences of Christmas in her village and church. She then attended the 2nd of the Celebration Assemblies. Next term we are going to follow her preparation for The Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast in Australia- April 2018- and then track the progress of Uganda Netball Team at the event. In the summer term we will arrange a visit to Loughborough to watch Peace play in the Super league (the netball equivalent of footballs Premier League)
