**DADWAVERS Openers**

Description – The brontosaurus had a long neck and was around 23m long.

Action – Whipping predators with its tail was the brontosaurus’ best defence.

Dialogue- **Unnecessary in this case but you could use a quote.**

Where things are- Inside its stomach, stones were used to grind up food.

Adverb – Amazingly, scientists argued for over 100 years about whether the brontosaurus existed.

Verb – Eating was difficult as the brontosaurus had a weak jaw and small teeth.

Estimation of time – 150 million years ago the brontosaurus roamed the earth.


Rhetorical Question- Did you know a brontosaurus weighed the same as 6 elephants?

Simile/Metaphor – Its tail was like a whip and helped to keep its balance.

**Note: DADWAVERS should be taught in small steps. In KS1 you may only wish to cover DAD or DADWAV. You may wish to only focus on one step and ask that the children practise this element until they are confident. You might choose to use some steps with selected groups only.**
