	LED BY?	THEME	Learning Intention	RESOURCES/display
Monday			To give examples of respectful things to say and respectful actions.	<p>Divide the room into 2. Give each half a piece of paper. Ask them to write 'things we say' in the middle of one piece and 'things we do' on the other piece. Alternatively, they could draw a mouth on the first piece and a person on the other. Ask each group to write down as many ideas for things people say when they are being respectful on the first sheet of paper.</p> <p>Ask each group to share their thoughts with the everyone at the end. Leave these on the display area.</p>
Tuesday			To consider how we can show respect for our environment.	<p>Show the children slide 4, which has the following saying on it: <i>Take nothing but memories, leave nothing but footprints.</i></p> <p>Explore with the class what they think this saying means. Give practical examples, picking up litter.</p>

<p>Wednesday</p>			<p>To consider how we can show respect to ourselves.</p>	<p>Respecting yourself</p> <p>Explain to the class that respect starts from the inside.</p> <p>In order to respect other people and things you must first learn to respect yourself.</p> <p>Show the class slide 5.</p> <p>Ask them to shout out some ideas for how they can show respect for themselves.</p>
<p>Thursday</p>			<p>To consider how we can show respect to ourselves.</p>	<p>Using worksheet 2, which has the outline of a child, write words, or phrases around the outside to show the different ways they can show respect for themselves.</p> <p>Ideas might include: by eating healthy, by being active, by surrounding themselves with positive people who encourage and support them, by talking to someone they trust when they are struggling, by always trying to do the right thing and not letting other people convince them to do something they feel is wrong, by trying to have a positive attitude.</p> <p>Conclude the activity by showing the class slide 7</p>
