(link to Abraham and Noah) Second Candle We work for peace – Christians believe Jesus is the 'Prince of Peace' and Christians work for peace in his name. (Link to the stories of Moses, David etc and their commitment to following God) Third Candle We show love – Christians believe Jesus gave everything for them. (link to week 3 and the gift of Jesus birth) Fourth Candle We share joy – Christians believe the Holy Spirit fills their hearts and minds with the presence and joy of God (link to week 3 and the joy of those who announced Jesus birth and visited him) Last (Central) Candle (Christmas Day) the last candle is to remember the birth of Jesus Christ.
