Tuesday		PEACE	Generosity: Unconditional Generosity	Have birthday paraphernalia (balloons, streamers etc) on worship table. How do they prepare for a party? How do they know who to invite? Jesus loved to celebrate with people – V4L p279 . Read 'The Big Party' Lion Storyteller Bible. Read from beginning to 'Hooray for God and for everyone who gets to go to his party in heaven'. What was Jesus trying to teach us in this story? Introduce new value of GENEROSITY.
Wednesday		PEACE	Generosity: Unconditional Generosity	A birthday party is a time to be generous and share your special day with friends. How did the King in the story feel when his friends turned down his invitation? Thursday			Generosity: Unconditional Generosity	Look at Epiphany (Jan 6th ) and how the Magi (3 Wise Men ) brought gifts. Twinkl ppt slide 4 – looking at the significance of the gifts.. ideally light an incense stick for frankincense. Point out that even though Christmas is over, part of the story with the gifts didn't happen until after Christmas. How and why were the Wise Men generous?
Friday			Generosity: Unconditional Generosity	<p>Display the images of the Magi and Epiphany again. · What can we learn from this story? The wise men responded to the birth of Jesus by finding him, worshipping him and bringing him gifts. They understood that Jesus was not just any king; he was the fulfillment of God's promise! Jesus says that he's with us, which means that you guys can turn to him and worship him at any time! · When the wise men gave Jesus gifts, it was their way of saying that he is a very special king who would make a way for all the world to come to God. Many people believe that the gifts that the Wise Men gave made it possible for Jesus' family to start a new life in Egypt, because they probably didn't have a lot of money. God looked after Jesus and his family through the generosity of the Wise Men. · When we give gifts to others it's an opportunity for us to express our love for Jesus and for others. God can also use our gifts to look after others.</p> <p>Our school council will meet to start a new fundraiser to promote generosity for others.</p>
