Monday		GENEROSITY	<b>Generosity: Unconditional Generosity</b>	<i>Catch up from last weeks missed worships due to snow closures</i> Look at Epiphany (Jan 6th ) and how the Magi (3 Wise Men ) brought gifts. Twinkl ppt slide 4 – looking at the significance of the gifts.. ideally light an incense stick for frankincense. Point out that even though Christmas is over, part of the story with the gifts didn’t happen until after Christmas. How and why were the Wise Men generous?
Tuesday		GENEROSITY	<b>Generosity: Unconditional Generosity</b>	<i>Catch up from last weeks missed worships due to snow closures</i> Display the images of the Magi and Epiphany again. · What can we learn from this story? The wise men responded to the birth of Jesus by finding him, worshipping him and bringing him gifts. They understood that Jesus was not just any king; he was the fulfillment of God’s promise! Jesus says that he’s with us, which means that you guys can turn to him and worship him at any time! · When the wise men gave Jesus gifts, it was their way of saying that he is a very special king who would make a way for all the world to come to God. Many people believe that the gifts that the Wise Men gave made it possible for Jesus’ family to start a new life in Egypt, because they
